

Need a FREE and FUN way to help your students review before their ACT/SAT/ASVAB test?

All you need is a Johnson County Library Card.

The Johnson County Library website has more to offer than looking up books. It is also a great resource for test preparations information. All you will need to know is your library card number and the pin number along with it. If you don't remember your pin number the instructions to reset it are at the end of this article.

Steps to find test preparation:

- 1) Go to [www.jocolibrary.com](http://www.jocolibrary.com)
- 2) Click on the Research tab
- 3) Under the heading "Research by Format" choose Practice Exams and Test Preparation
- 4) On the left half of the screen click on the link to Learning Express Library
- 5) At this point you will have to enter in you library number and pin to be able to go to the website.
- 6) You should have access to the Learning Express Library. On the left click on College Preparation.
- 7) Choose ACT Preparation, under this menu there are several option. There are timed practice test for all sections of the ACT. Also there are courses that will review the information seen on the test and have practice problems.
- 8) Once you have found an item that you would like to work on, at the right on your menu it says Login to add. Click on the plus sign.
- 9) This will bring you to a page that will ask you to login. If you have not been on this site before you will need to create a new account.
- 10) Once you have created an account, the site should show "My Center" page. On this page anything that you want to work on will be saved here.
- 11) After you have created an account you can go to any menu and save practice tests on different topics that will all be saved to "My Center".

After you have created an account you can always go back to the site and find all of you saved courses and practice tests under the "My Center" link that is found at the top right of your screen.

- 1) On the Johnson County main website, select Using the Library.
- 2) On this page, under "The Basics" select, Library Cards and Pins
- 3) Then on the left of the page there is a section called: "PINS", selected the topic that applies to you.
