Finally, the learning environment in the Spring Hill School District is truly top-notch. Thanks to a strong partnership with the community, all district schools have been renovated or are new since 2006. These district-wide projects ensured classrooms are state-of-the-art learning centers, including MacBook Air laptops for all middle and high school students and technology-infused classrooms at the elementary level to support curriculum and instruction. In addition, many security upgrades have been put into place, as a priority is to ensure the wellbeing of students and staff.
