

Explanation of Coding for Foreign Language Curriculum Spreadsheet

FLEX – FLEX is the acronym for Foreign Language Exploration. All middle school students take a foreign language class in sixth and seventh grade. The sixth grade class is exposed to Spanish while the seventh grade students participate in a French class. The sixth grade class is part of a trimester experience. The seventh grade experience is a semester class.

Level I – Students taking a Level I class are enrolled in their first year long course of foreign language. Expectations of students are to begin to learn basic skills in a foreign language.

Level II – Students enrolled in a Level II class will continue to refine their foreign language skills and begin to learn more about the country's culture.

Level III – Level III is the highest level of the foreign language experience that Spring Hill students can complete. Skills within this class allows for students to be completely immersed in the country's culture and language.
