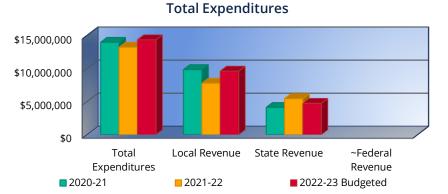


Total Expenditures per Pupil

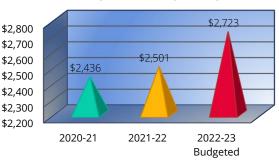

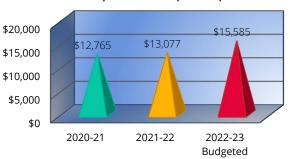
