



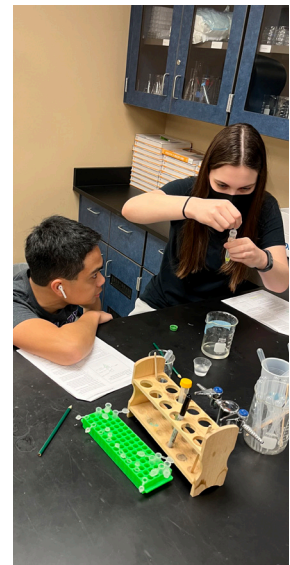
Spring Hill Schools
